Notice of Race

Dave Cool Icebreaker Regatta, April 26 – April 27/2008

J/22 Fleet #1, Lake Minnetonka, MN

Rules: This event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS 2005-2008), the prescriptions of U.S. Sailing, this Notice of Race, the rules of the J22 class, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions, & the Sailing Instructions. The same crew and the same three class sails must be used the entire regatta. There can be substitutions only with the approval of the organizing authority. Yachts (including rudders) may not be removed from the water during the regatta without the approval of the organizing authority. The regatta is classified as a category “C” event. Sailing instructions will be distributed at registration.

Eligibility: J/22 Class yachts in compliance with class rules will be scored. Skippers/Owners must show current J/22 Class cards to be eligible to race.

Location: The racing area is on Lake Minnetonka, on the Main Lake or in Wayzata Bay.

Fees: The entry fee is \$75.00. All registration fees are payable prior to 4/26/2008, 9:30AM. Entry fee includes adult refreshments, food & entertainment.

Scoring: The Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A2 of the IYRR, will apply, with six races scheduled of which one shall be completed to constitute a series. Each boat may exclude her worst score if six races have been completed.

Trophies: Trophies will be awarded for the top 3 finishers.

Inspection & Measurements: All participants are subject to inspection and measurement at any time during the regatta. The organizing authority may, at its discretion, inspect any yacht in order to confirm compliance with the prescribed class rules concerning construction and measurements, safety rules when racing, crew prohibition and restrictions when racing. Class royalty tags must be present on all sails. Crew will be weighed in at registration. Max. crew weight is 605 lbs.

Registration & Put-in: The crane at Wayzata Yacht Club will be available from 12:00, Noon on Friday 4/25. Only J/22's registered to race will be able to use the crane. Registration and weigh-in at WYC.

Races 2, 3 and 4 to follow back-to-back or as notified at the finish of each race. 4 races are scheduled for Saturday but the PRO may, at his discretion, decide on the

number of races depending on time and conditions.
